## **Fixture Secretary Report**

EDVA Mixed Tournament 6<sup>th</sup> Feb 2011 Entry forms now out.

The leagues are now well underway and on the whole running smoothly, however Exeter University have been late with returning scoresheets, one for each of their 3 teams. The Division Two scoresheets were handed over at the meeting and the teams have been fined accordingly, but the Div One Panda's scoresheet is still outstanding. Late match report fines have been issued to Torexe Phantoms and Kirton.

There was an issue with the fixture between WVC Raptors and Birdmen, scheduled to be played on 28<sup>th</sup> November, when despite having submitted 9 names to the prison in good time, injuries, including a late cycling accident and illness meant that Raptors couldn't field a team and couldn't include additional players at the last minute, due to the prison rules. This was put to the committee as to whether, owing to the exceptional circumstances, the match could be postponed.
